

Important Implementation Results of June 2019

On June 5, together with the Ministry of Health and Welfare (MOHW), Council of Agriculture (COA), Ministry of Education (MOE) and Ministry of Economic Affairs (MOEA), the EPA launched the World Food Safety Day – Food Safety is Our Responsibilities and a Guarantee for Your Health interdepartmental press conference, encouraging and calling all citizens to respond to the World Food Safety Day. Additionally, in coordination with the Million Green Point activity, on June 17, the 50 winners of the NTD200 convenience store gift voucher were also announced on its Facebook fan page.

On June 11, the EPA held the 2019 Jade Mountain Forum on Sustainable Environment and Seminar on the Management and Communication of Emerging Contaminants in Sites of High-Potential Occurrence at National Cheng Kung University. The Forum and Seminar engaged in discussions that focused on the better management of emerging contaminants in sites of

high-technology, consumer goods, pharmaceutical and chemical industries with high-potential occurrence. At this event, 17 experts and scholars were invited to deliver a speech and interact with the audience, helping to enhance the audience's awareness towards emerging contaminants and establish practical methods and mechanisms for preventing and mitigating potential emerging contaminants.

3. Held the on-campus disaster prevention education program *Change Dangers into Opportunities: Creating a Safe Campus* at National Tsing Hua University on June 17. Deputy Minister Shen of the EPA was invited to deliver a speech, and representatives from the Ministry of Education and Hsinchu City Government were also invited to join this event.
