

Performance of the Toxic and Chemical Substances Bureau, Environmental Protection Administration, Executive Yuan in October 2022

1. On October 13, the EPA and the National Science and Technology Center for Disaster Reduction jointly signed a memorandum of understanding on research and development and application of disaster prevention and relief technology for toxic and chemical substances, and simultaneously issued a press release to let the public understand government agencies' efforts to actively refine domestic toxic and chemical substance disaster prevention and relief technology.

On October 28, the ChemiCloud inter-ministerial conference was held to report "ChemiCloud -- Inter-Ministerial Chemical Substance Information Service Platform Achievements" and "Chemical Substance Management and Toxic Substances Disaster Reduction Information System Refinement and Promotion Status," and to discuss issues such as "Confirmation of Domestic High-Risk Physical Hazardous Chemicals Information," "Operational Background Information on the Operators Interfacing the Industrial Park Disaster Safety Protection System of the Industrial Development Bureau, MOEA, with the ChemiCloud," and "Granting of the Inquiry Permission for Drug Investigation Information of the Ministry of Justice."
