Major Policies in December 2022

1. On December 19, the TCSB participated in the "5th Government Service Awards Ceremony" at the National Taiwan University Hospital International Convention Center, and received the award for the project, "From Visual to Telemetry, Viewing Taiwan from Space -- Telemetry on Asbestos Tile Roofs."
2. From December 12 to 14, the "Toxic and Chemical Substances of Concern Professional Response Staff Training -- Kinmen Workshop" and the "Kinmen County Toxic Chemical Disaster Emergency Mutual Support Agreement" signing ceremony were held, with TCSB Director General Yein-Rui Hsieh as the witness of the signing. Ten agencies, including the Environmental Protection Bureau, the Fire Bureau, and the Public Health Bureau of Kinmen County, signed the agreement to assist each other in disaster prevention and response based on the principle of "resource sharing" and to combine training for toxic and chemical disaster response personnel to enhance the response skills, horizontal communication, and mutual understanding of local response personnel in disaster relief.
3. On December 14, the "Regulations Governing the Disclosure of Potential Information on Toxic Chemical Substance Disasters" were amended and promulgated, and the "Regulations Governing the Recognition of National Disaster Prevention and Relief Education for Toxic and Concerned Chemical Disasters and Particulate Matter Disasters" were finalized and promulgated.
