Chemicals Administration, Ministry of Environment Major Policy Implementations in July 2024

- 1. On July 2, Minister Peng Chi-ming hosted the "1st Consultative Meeting of the National Chemical Substance Management Board for Year 2024." Committee members who are experts, scholars, and representatives of private groups, as well as participation from governmental agencies were invited to discuss improvements in management measures related to the LTC factory fire, response measures for hazardous chemical accidents, and management of school laboratory chemical substances.
- 2. The "Singapore Chemicals Management Strategy Exchange" took place from July 7 to 11. Director Hsieh Yein-rui led a delegation to Singapore to visit agencies responsible for chemical management, exchanging ideas and experiences on strategies for managing Per and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), approaches to implementing the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS), the Singapore Chemicals Management Fund, and related topics such as the regulatory fee system.
- 3. The "2024 Meeting on Management of Toxic and Concerned Chemical Substances and Environmental Agents, and Environmental Toxic Accidents Review" took place on July 30 and 31. The meeting aimed to foster exchange and discussion with local environmental agencies to strengthen the management of toxic and concerned chemical substances, environmental agents, and related environmental accidents, while also enhancing administrative efficiency in management.
