## **Major Policy Implementations in April 2026**

1. The "2026 Training Programme on Preventive Chemicals Control: PFAS Management and Enforcement" was held from April 14 to 16. Experts from the Swedish Chemicals Agency (KEMI), Japan's National Institute for Environmental Studies, the Customs Administration of the Ministry of Finance, and National Taiwan University (NTU) were invited to share insights on chemical management issues, including border enforcement, safety data sheet compliance, PFAS management, and database applications.
2. On April 27, the MOENV announced amendments to the "Categories and Management of Handling for Toxic Chemical Substances", adding Methoxychlor, Dechlorane Plus, and 2-(2H-benzotriazol-2-yl)-4,6-di-tert-pentylphenol (UV-328) as newly controlled toxic chemical substances. The MOENV also revised the management regulations for mercury and perchloroethylene to align with international trends in chemical substance management and to strengthen the overall management of toxic chemical substances nationwide.
