Major Policy Implementations in August 2026

1. On August 17 and 18, the Chemicals Administration held a briefing session each in Kaohsiung City and Taipei City, titled “Briefing Session for Registrants on Submitting Information on Hazard and Exposure Assessment by the Specified Deadline (2027).” The sessions were held to implement the collection of domestic exposure information, explaining to designated registrants how to submit information on hazard and exposure assessment by the specified deadline for three chemical substances. These substances were selected for their high volume of domestic manufacturing or import registration cases and their wide range of uses.
2. The Administration completed a cross-ministerial compilation of the 2025 implementation results of the United Nations Minamata Convention Promotion Implementation Plan, and published the compilation on August 27 on its website designated for information on the Minamata Convention on Mercury.
